(Minimum of two students)

The Virtual Program is designed for students—both adults and youth—with special or extenuating circumstances (such as distance, health, etc.) that prevent in-person attendance. \$1200 (1st student per family), **\$1175** (2nd student per family), **\$1150** (3rd, 4th + student ...).

****PLEASE NOTE: A minimum enrollment of two students is required to initiate and continue a class for the academic year, pending teacher availability. In the case of a single enrolled student, the class will be treated as a private lesson, with tuition adjusted based on the student's level.**

****Private lessons** are scheduled for one hour per session, and the price depends on the level of Greek language proficiency as well as the specific learning goals of the student.
